




1. How long have you been attending the Church of the Resurrection? ⁵¹ responses







2. On average, how often do you attend the Church of the Resurrection in-person? 51 responses





3. Which service do you typically attend when you come to church to worship? ⁵¹ responses






4. After worship in-person, do you typically attend the fellowship hour following services? ⁵¹ responses




5. Do you watch the Church of the Resurrection Sunday services on-line if you do not attend church in-person?




Do you typically watch any weekday church services on-line?

7. Do you participate or attend any parish activities outside of regular worship? ⁵¹ responses













21. Do you have a preference regarding the gender of our next Rector? ⁵¹ responses






22. Do you have a preference regarding the age of our next Rector? ⁵¹ responses







23. Do you have a preference regarding the work experience of our next Rector? ⁵¹ responses





24. Do you have a preference regarding the sexual orientation of our next Rector? ⁵¹ responses






25. Do you have a preference regarding the marital status of our next Rector? ⁵¹ responses
